<p>STRIPED SHIRTS Cotton/Polyester</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warm machine wash with like colours • Do not soak • Do not bleach • Do not tumble dry • Dry in shade • Warm iron • Dry cleanable (P)
<p>KNIT WEAR Viscose/Nylon</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wash inside out • Cold handwash or gentle machine wash with similar colours • Do not soak • Do not wring • Do not bleach • Do not tumble dry • Lay flat in shade to dry away from direct sunlight • Cool iron on reverse • Dry cleanable (P)

<p>HI VIS POLOS: Polyester</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cold machine wash with like colours • Do not bleach • Do not tumble dry • Do not iron • Avoid exposure to flame and heat • This garment complies to standards at time of manufacture. Misuse, excessive dirt or long exposure to UV may impair the level of fabric chromaticity
<p>HI VIS SOFT SHELL & RAIN JACKETS</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not machine wash • Gentle hand wash in cool water • Do not use bleach • Do not iron • Do not dry clean • Do not soak • Drip dry in shade
<p>WORKWEAR PANTS AND SHORTS: Cotton Drill</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warm machine wash with like colours • Dry inside out away from direct sunlight to avoid fading • Do not bleach • Do not tumble dry • Warm iron • Dry cleanable (P)

<p>HI VIS SAFETY VESTS (TAPED OR NON TAPED): Polyester</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cold machine wash • Drip dry in shade • Do not soak or leave wet overnight • Do not bleach or use strong detergents • Do not iron • Do not dry clean
<p>ALL OTHER POLOS: Polyester/cotton</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warm gentle machine wash • Wash with like colours • Wash inside out • Do not bleach or use strong detergents • Do not soak • Do not tumble dry • Drip dry in shade • Warm iron inside out • Dry cleanable (P)

CARE INSTRUCTION DEFINITIONS

Warm machine Wash

Use water that is warm, typically around 30°C to 40°C (85°F to 105°F). This temperature is effective for cleaning while being gentle on the fabric.

Wash with like colours

Wash the garment with other items of similar colours to prevent colour bleeding or transfer. For example, wash darks with darks, lights with lights, and avoid mixing bright or vibrant colours with whites.

Wash inside out

Turn the garment inside out before washing. This protects the outer fabric or designs (such as prints or embroidery) from abrasion during the wash.

Do not bleach or use strong detergents

Avoid using bleach or harsh cleaning products that can weaken fibers, fade colours, or damage embellishments. Opt for mild or colour-safe detergents.

Do not soak

Do not leave the garment submerged in water for an extended period. Soaking can cause colours to bleed or the fabric to weaken, especially for delicate materials.

Do not tumble dry

Avoid using a dryer, as the heat and tumbling action can shrink, distort, or damage the fabric.

Drip dry in shade

After washing, hang the garment to dry naturally, letting water drip off. Dry in a shaded area to prevent direct sunlight from fading the fabric or altering its texture.

Warm iron inside out

Use a warm (not hot) iron and press the garment inside out to protect any prints, embroidery, or delicate surfaces.

Dry cleanable (P)

The garment can be professionally dry-cleaned, and the "(P)" indicates that only solvents suitable for "Professional Cleaning in Perchloroethylene" should be used. This is a common cleaning method for delicate or structured fabrics.
